

A LETTER FROM THE TREASURER

I have served on the Board of On The Rock Ministries since its birth in early 1998. How that happened is easily explained: A local church released its Youth Director which put Ken Dossett in the job market. A core group of supporters rallied around Ken's vision for youth outreach in Bartlesville. They established On The Rock Ministries and hired Ken as the director. It was a rare time when I was certain that it was God's will for me to be involved.

My prior experience with Ken showed that he had uncommon passion for young people and extreme willingness to follow the Spirit of God to win as many as possible for Christ. Ken spared no effort in pursuing this mission. Ten years has not changed his nature nor has it changed my impression of it.



In addition to exposing the Gospel of Christ to a mostly unchurched generation, The Rock models family leadership and values with generous portions of love, instruction, recreation and fellowship. The Rock staff exhibits outreach with the outgoing love of Jesus by picking kids up where they are and transporting them to a wide range of Godly activities and experiences, from The Rock to the world.

As the youth culture steadily erodes, the need for The Rock is obviously increasing. However, the core support that has sustained The Rock has changed over time. For The Rock to continue to pursue and expand its God given mission, new partners must be enlisted. This letter puts to the test Jesus' promise: "Ask and it will be given to you." (Matthew 7:7)
